TENNIS ASIA CUP- 2007

This is further to my letter dated 17th September 2007.

*We are closing on to the D-Day for the inaugural conduct of the Asian historic event the US \$ 100,000 'Tennis Asia Cup 2007' for Men from **28th November to 2nd December 2007**, at Bangkok, Thailand. The event will also commemorate His Majesty the King of Thailand's 80th birth anniversary. The King would be presenting a trophy to the ATF for the event which will decide the Asian Master. This is just the beginning of the steps we are going to take to ensure that the Asian players get full share of opportunities to ensure financial security, recognition, motivation and satisfaction while pursuing tennis as their desired career and entertainment. We are inviting the top eight players in Asia to participate in the year-end event.*

The "Tennis Asia Cup" will be held on a similar format as the ITF / ATF Masters event. It will be a perpetual feature and circulate in the Asian Regions in the coming years. A trophy will be awarded to the ATF Master each year. The trophy will keep moving to other countries in coming years.

*We have also decided to have a **JUNIOR MIXED TEAM** event to be held during the same time **26 Nov – 3 Dec 2007**. All the members of the ATF are invited to send a team comprising of 2 boys and 2 girls (U/16) with a coach / captain to represent their National Associations. The rules and regulations of the ITF junior team competition will be followed during the event.*

This is an Asian Initiative and I would expect your personal indulgence to ensure that all nations are represented in the junior mixed team event. It will be a great motivation for our junior players to play alongside the top Asian Players. We would like to send a message that Asians are becoming aware of their share in the destiny of tennis. Let's work in a united manner and ensure that the event is a great success.

I expect all nations to participate in the junior mixed event and support our efforts to bring Asian tennis to a higher notch.

I am attaching further information for both the events for your reference and action.
