



KNOW YOUR ATT!

Asian Tennis Tour (ATT), is a pioneering initiative from Asian Tennis Federation developed with the sole intention of providing more opportunities for Asian players to compete in world-class tournaments across Asia.

What is Asian Tennis Tour (ATT)?

ATT is a independent circuit comprising of around 50-60 tournaments held across Asia. The Tour will run across the tennis calendar and will be open to all Asian players (Aged 14 years and above) who are citizens of any of the 44 Asian Tennis Federation affiliated countries and holding a valid passport or identity card. ATT will have 4 categories of events:

US \$3000 Closed tournaments - Only Singles (Participation restricted to players from the host nation)

US\$ 3000 Open Tournaments - Only Singles

US\$ 6000 Open Tournaments - Only Singles

US\$ 10000 Open Tournaments - Singles & Doubles

How will Asian Tennis Tour benefit Asian players?

- a) Opportunity to play in International tournaments, thereby helping in the transition to pro-circuits.
- b) Availability of International points and rankings: ATT points and ATT rankings are great launch-pads to international pro-circuits for promising young Asian players
- c) Possibilities of wild-card allotments for pro-circuit tournaments based on ATT rankings.
- d) Possibilities of future tie-ups with Grand slams for top ATT ranked players.
- e) Opportunity to play in prize money tournaments and earn money
- f) ATT closed tournaments provide a fantastic opportunity for local players to play in an international circuit (at home) and earn ATT points and rankings.

How to participate in Asian Tennis Tour?

To participate in the Tour, the players are required to obtain Asian Player Identification Number (APIN). This can be done online from the Asian Tennis Federation website. Just log on to Asian Tennis Federation website www.asiantennis.com , go to the ATT page and register for Asian Player Identification Number (APIN).

APIN will be valid for one calendar year and come with a nominal fee of US \$20/year.

Entering ATT Tournaments:

All players with valid APIN registrations and aged 14 years and above are eligible to enter ATT tournaments held across Asia.(The players age as of the first day of the tournament Main Draw will be used for this purpose.) In the case of closed tournaments, only players from the host nation are eligible to enter. All entries to tournaments are done through the APIN Online Interface at www.asiantennis.com. Registered players can enter tournaments by first accessing this interface using their APIN and password and then selecting the tournaments they wish to enter.

Entry Fees:

Entry fees for USD10000 events will be USD20/player for main draw and qualifying. For the USD3000 and USD6000 events, entry fees will be USD 20/player for main draw and USD10/player for qualifying draws.

Match Format:

All main draw matches and final round of qualifying will be played best of 3 tie break sets. The other round of qualifying matches will be played best of 3 sets, first 2 sets being normal tie break sets, while a 10 point match tie break being played in lieu of final set in case score becomes one set all.

Player Acceptances:

Acceptances will be based on the following order of priority:

1. ATP / WTA Rankings
2. ITF World Rankings
3. ITF World Junior Rankings
4. National Rankings
5. Unranked

Seeding will be done purely on the basis of ATP/WTA and ITF World Rankings. From 2020 season, ATT rankings will be given first priority for seeding.

Entry and Withdrawal deadlines:

All entries and withdrawals will be done online, through APIN Online Interface for the registered players. No emails will be accepted. Real time entries will be available for the players at any given time.

Entry deadline will be 12:00 pm Indian Standard Time, 14 days prior to tournament Monday and Withdrawal deadline will be 12:00 pm Indian Standard Time, 7 days prior to the tournament Monday.

Players will be permitted to enter only one tournament in one week, with no exception. Freeze deadline will be 12:00 pm Indian Standard Time on Thursday prior to the tournament Monday.

ATT Rankings:

Players participating in ATT tournaments will be awarded ATT points, based on the points table as listed below.

The ATT Rankings could become relevant in future as:

- ATT rankings will be given first priority for seeding from 2020
- ATT rankings could be used to allot wild cards to bigger pro-circuit tournaments held in Asia from 2020.
