## KOREA COME ON TOP IN GIRLS' ASIA/OCEANIA FINAL QUALIFYING OF ITF WORLD JUNIOR TENNIS COMPETITION 2025



Opening Ceremony

Korea emerged victorious in the ITF World Junior Tennis Competition Asia-Oceania Final Qualifying (Girls), edging out Japan 2-1 in the title clash.

Champions Korea along with finalist Japan, Chinese Taipei, and China earned their tickets to the prestigious ITF World Junior Tennis Finals set for August in Prostějov, Czech Republic.



Medal Ceremony



The competition ran from April 2-7 at the Sarawak Lawn Tennis Association courts in Kuching, Malaysia. Sixteen nations from across Asia and Oceania competed for the top four spots.

After three days of intense round-robin play, the quarterfinals were decided, with China, New Zealand, Japan, Korea, Chinese Taipei, Kazakhstan, Australia, and Hong Kong, China advancing.

In the semi-finals, Korea put up a dominating show by sweeping Chinese Taipei 2-0, while Japan triumphed over China 2-0.

In the third-place playoff, Chinese Taipei claimed a 2-0 victory over China.

As the event wraps up, the Asian Tennis Federation congratulates Korea and the other three Asian teams that made it through to the ITF WJT Finals. All four will now represent Asia along with best junior teams from around the world battling for top honors.
