

TEAMS FOR DAVIS CUP JUNIORS IDENTIFIED



Team Japan capped off a dominant campaign in Shymkent emerging as winners at the Davis Cup Juniors Asia-Oceania Final Qualifying, sealing the victory with a commanding 2-0 scoreline over Korea in the final.

In the playoff for third place, Chinese Taipei edged past China in a hard-fought 2-1 tie and secured a well-earned podium finish.

Earlier in the semi-finals, Japan scored a commanding 2-0 win over Chinese Taipei. Korea, meanwhile, battled through a tightly contested 2-1 encounter against China, pulling through in the doubles to earn their spot in the final.

The week-long event on Shymkent’s clay courts brought together 16 nations from across Asia and Oceania. From early group stages to high-pressure knockout rounds, the event featured a display of top junior talent, all competing for a coveted ticket to the DCJ Finals.

With qualification now complete, four teams from Asia—Japan, Korea, Chinese Taipei, and China—will compete at the 2025 Davis Cup Juniors Finals in Chile this November.

After finishing champions, Japan will try to keep their good form going at the world finals. Korea, Chinese Taipei, and China will also head to Chile with confidence, ready to take on the top teams from around the world.
